

<<< KIT Network Usage Rules >>>

Kyushu Institute of Technology(KIT) prohibits the following:

1. Offending against public order and morals.
2. Violating copyright or patent laws or restrictions.
3. Purposing use unauthorized by KIT, possibly with commercial, religious, or political aspects.
4. Allowing use of a computer account and password by any unauthorized person.
5. Attempting to obtain another user's ID or password.
6. Attempting unauthorized access to another user's files or software.
7. Transmitting inappropriate mails, such as "chain mails" or "SPAMs".
8. Interfering with the normal operation of any computer and network system.
9. In addition, acting against laws or public morals, or interfering with other's ability of use.

Violating users will be held accountable for their conduct, possibly resulting in loss of user privileges and/or legal prosecution.
