Kyushu Institute of Technology(KIT) prohibits the following:

- 1. Offending against public order and morals.
- 2. Violating copyright or patent laws or restrictions.
- 3. Purposing use unauthorized by KIT, possibly with commercial, religious, or political aspects.
- 4. Allowing use of a computer account and password by any unauthorized person.
- 5. Attempting to obtain another user's ID or password.
- 6. Attempting unauthorized access to another user's files or software.
- 7. Transmitting inappropriate mails, such as "chain mails" or "SPAMs".
- 8. Interfering with the normal operation of any computer and network system.
- 9. In addition, acting against laws or public morals, or interfering with other's ability of use.

Violating users will be held accountable for their conduct, possibly resulting in loss of user privileges and/or legal prosecution.
